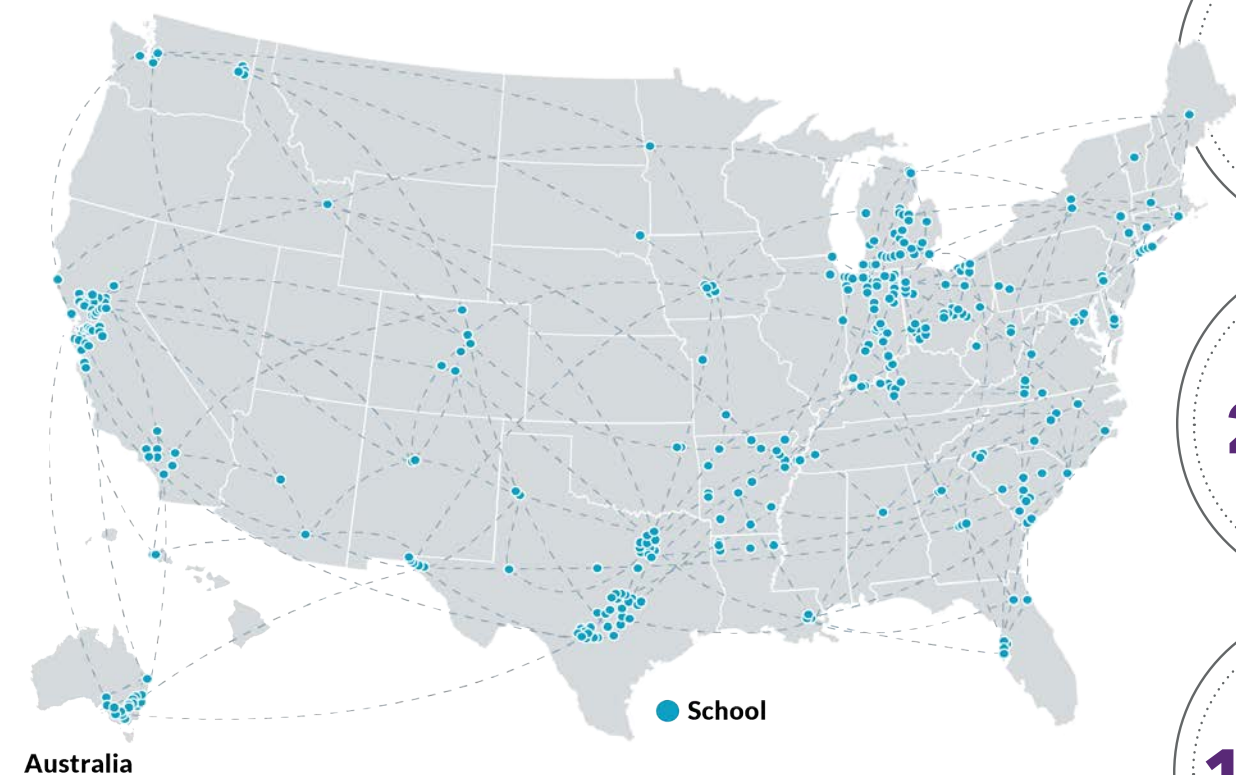

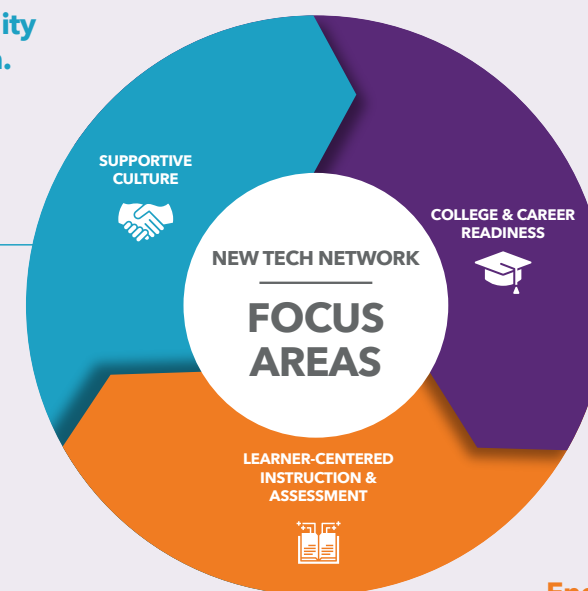

Implementation

NTN 360 Services

The NTN 360 is a whole school approach to transformation that allows schools to create comprehensive strategies in the NTN Focus Areas in ways that reach all teachers and all students across a school community. Using onsite coaching, national events, and online tools, NTN 360 provides differentiated support to school leadership teams, grade level content teams, and individual teachers.

School Design & Planning

Format: Onsite & Virtual • Duration: Varies

Prior to launching NTN 360 at your school, an NTN school design expert will work closely with your leadership team to design and support your school community. This support includes five days of virtual school planning through ongoing monthly consulting calls and one onsite day prior to the start of the school year. This support includes:

- School Design and Implementation consulting: customized planning support from our experts and access to NTN proprietary planning resources and project and content libraries.
- Planning and Implementation support: monthly 1:1 planning calls with the school leadership team and stakeholders to build readiness toward NTN implementation.

Your NTN consultant will spend a minimum of one onsite day to be customized to meet the needs of the school. Activities may include a/an:

- NTN Executive Tour: guided tour at an NTN school to provide the opportunity to visit classrooms, talk with teachers, students, and school and district leaders.
- Planning Visit: an onsite visit from an NTN Director of School Development to engage stakeholders, raise awareness, and assess progress toward implementing the NTN Model.

Leadership Residency

Two Days • Onsite

Leadership Residency is a two-day event designed to prepare school leadership teams for the implementation of NTN360. Through this experience, participants will understand the key elements of NTN360 and how school leaders can create the necessary conditions to implement and sustain these practices over time. This event will also include the opportunity to connect with and learn from other school leadership teams that have successfully implemented NTN360 practices, as part of the two-day experience.

PBL360

Three Days • Onsite

This event occurs locally in your district prior to NTN360 launch. It is an intensive 3-day experience that will provide an opportunity for participants to learn about the NTN360 model design. Staff from schools joining the New Tech Network will learn best practices in authentic, inquiry-based project- and problem-based learning (PBL/PrBL), school culture, and technology that work together to produce a learning environment that enables all students to experience deeper learning and be college and career ready. School Principal/Director and year one implementing staff are expected to attend.

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NTN 360 School Coaching

Five to Six Days • Onsite

NTN 360 School Coaching is designed for schools in year 1-3 of NTN 360 implementation and includes 5-6 onsite coaching days per year, and ongoing virtual and remote support. Coaching supports are focused on core aspects of NTN 360 including assessing learning outcomes, developing a positive culture, and designing high quality projects. NTN staff work with School Leadership Teams to identify professional learning opportunities (including whole team, small group, and individual coaching) throughout the school year.

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Renewal

NTN 360 Services

Upon completing the implementation phase of NTN 360, schools work with their coach to identify a customized plan to support sustainability efforts over the long term.

Sustainability Pathway

Three Days • Onsite & Virtual

One Day • Virtual Leadership • Monthly Coaching Calls

The Sustainability Pathway is designed to build a leadership team’s capacity to support school staff through intentional and impactful adult learning. The pathway is customized through cycles of inquiry, tailored to each school’s specific needs and grounded in school-based data.

This service includes leadership and school team workshops, ten monthly coaching calls, and one year of NTN Annual Membership.

- NTN Refresh | Designed for schools that have experienced significant teacher and/or leader transitions and want to re-engage with their school’s “why”, calibrate on building a vibrant school culture, and renew their PBL training. The NTN school coach works closely with the school’s leadership team to help develop their capacity-building skills to best support staff in the NTN Model. The coach works directly with the school team during the workshops.
- Building Capacity | Designed to build the leadership team’s capacity to support school staff through intentional and effective adult learning. This suite relies heavily on cycles of inquiry customized to the school using school-based data; and the I Do, We Do, You Do model as we support leaders to develop skills and expertise in the design and delivery of professional development for their staff.

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Coaching for Leadership & School Teams

One Day • Onsite

This customizable coaching day provides support based on the specific needs of the school. This service includes an onsite visit from an NTN coach and ongoing remote support annually for planning time with the school leadership team. School leaders and their NTN coach will work together to determine what priorities to address at the onsite visit, which could include revisiting and/or developing the school journey map, co-designing and co-facilitating professional development to meet the school’s School Success Rubric goals, or classroom learning walks.

Coach Development Program 101

Year-Long Program • Virtual • Annual Membership Required

New Tech Network's Coach Development Program 101 is an online year-long course designed for instructional coaches and teacher leaders that builds local capacity within a district or school to support teacher development in project-based and problem-based instruction. This one-year program is designed for instructional staff who support continuous adult learning and utilizes a monthly virtual workshop model as part of a national cohort which allows for shared learning and collaborative reflections on coaching practices. Learning targets focus on coaching skills, strategies, iterative learning, and mindsets while supporting facilitation of a project-based learning (PBL)/ problem-based learning (PrBL) classroom environment. Year-long program. This program requires an NTN Annual Membership.

Coach Development Program 201

Year-Long Program • Virtual • Annual Membership Required

Coach Development Program 201 is an online advanced coaching development service designed for district and school instructional coaches and leaders who have completed the CDP 101 program. Building upon the foundation of CDP 101, CDP 201 focuses on the facilitation of adult learning, deepening daily coaching practices focused on student-centered deeper learning, and creating a strong coaching community. This service encourages collaborative learning across districts while empowering them to build internal capacity by translating virtual learning into practical applications within their unique contexts. This program is suited for school teams of two or more who have had at least one member who has completed CDP 101 and requires an NTN Annual Membership.

The first New Tech Network (NTN) school was founded in 1996, in Napa, California, as a collaboration between local entrepreneurs, teachers, and district leadership.



There was a shared desire to reimagine the high school experience so that students developed the skills and experience necessary to pursue and achieve success after graduation.

Napa New Technology High School (NNTHS) was founded with a reimagined school experience that was the genesis of a new school model: an attention to student and adult culture, and college and career readiness through the pervasive use of project-based learning.

This innovative approach to teaching and learning attracted national philanthropic support resulting in the organization today. New Tech Network is a nonprofit organization dedicated to systemic and equitable change in education. We center NTN schools – now more than 350 strong – as the units of change, and teachers and school leaders as the agents of that change. Working closely with leadership teams and classroom educators makes change scalable and sustainable.
